

COMPETITION RESTART

10TH JULY 2020

We are now moving into Stage 3 under the Indoor Sports COVID-Safe plan and the countdown is on until fixtures resume from Monday 13th July.

Under the plan we can have up to 500 people within the venue so we can also accommodate for the return of parents and spectators into the stadium. Please keep in mind however that social distancing requirements of 1.5m meter spacing will be in place for spectators and we still have strong requirements to be met around sanitisation of the stadium, hands and basketballs for all entering the facility.

NEW SIGN IN PROCEDURE

As we are still under restrictions, we are required to keep records for contact tracing, and we have implemented a new program to try and make this as smooth as possible and move to a contactless system. While the players will be captured through the Courtside system for games, spectators and other visitors to the facility will not.



We are using software called SwipedOn and as you enter the stadium you will see several signs with QR Codes on them at the entrance for you to sign in. If you can complete this process whilst waiting for the doors to open for you allocated game time this will speed up entry.

Either use your iPhone camera or download a QR Reader onto your phone through the App Store or Google play. The procedure then should be smooth if you follow these steps:

Step 1 – Scan the QR code at the door

- Step 2 Enter your details and the reason for your visit
- Step 3 Accept the terms and sign in
- Step 4 Sign out when leaving the stadium

If you are visiting with others who don't have the technology available you can also sign other people in on your device or we will have a tablet and manual sign in sheet available for those who don't have either option available to them.

As mentioned earlier this is only required for spectators and visitors for games.

COVID STAGE 3

We still must follow Stage 3 COVID rules and regulations with a quick guide for players and parents available from BQ <u>here</u>. Please remembers these following VIP rules to ensure we comply with regulations and continue to remain open:

- NO BASKETBALLS ALLOWED FOR TRAININGS OR GAMES.
- PLEASE DO NOT ARRIVE MORE THAN <u>10 MINUTES</u> PRIOR TO YOUR GAME/TRAINING
 - You will <u>NOT</u> be permitted to enter the building until all players and spectators have departed and the venue has been cleaned by staff
- PLEASE USE THE DESIGNATED ENTRY AND EXITS ONLY
- SANITISE YOUR HANDS REGULARLY
- SIGN IN & OUT USING THE QR CODE TO SPEED UP ENTRY AND EXIT FROM THE BUILDING
- THE CANTEEN WILL REMAIN CLOSED
- PLEASE BRING YOUR OWN WATER BOTTLE AND TOWEL
- SPECTATORS NEED TO MAINTAIN SOCIAL DISTANCING
- PLEASE FOLLOW ANY DIRECTION GIVEN BY CLIPPERS STAFF
